## Event Timing

The **Box Office** will be open from **11:00am-2:00pm** and reopen at **5:00pm** for wristband & merchandise pickup.

- **VIP Admission:** Gates open at **6:00 PM**
- **General Admission:** Gates open at **7:00 PM**

The film and live symphony performance will begin at **approximately 8:00 PM**

## Seating

- **General Admission (GA):** Lawn seating only. Guests may bring a **low-profile beach chair** (see example)



- Each ticket includes a **commemorative blanket** to sit on and a tote bag.

- A limited number of **ADA-approved chairs with backs** will be available in the GA area for those who need them. Please email [jaws@mvv.com](mailto:jaws@mvv.com) to arrange for this.
  - **VIP Admission:** Includes designated seating with **chairs with backs provided**—no need to bring your own.

## **ADA Accessibility**

- The venue is **partially ADA accessible**, with designated seating and staff support available.
  - **Please note:** The restroom trailers in the field are **not ADA compliant** however there are handicapped restrooms inside the Winnetu Resort
  - Guests needing accommodations are encouraged to **contact the event team in advance**.
  - English subtitles will appear onscreen during the film.

## **Food & Beverage**

- **Outside food and drinks are not permitted.**
  - **GA guests:** Concessions will be available for purchase, including snacks and beverages.
  - **VIP guests:** Food and drink are included in your experience.

## **Pets**

## **Transportation & Parking**

- There is limited parking on site for those who have purchased **VIP Parking Passes** and those with handicap placards (first come first serve)
  - There will be street parking along **Katama Rd. & Atlantic Drive**. As well as a complementary shuttle running from the Right Fork Beach lot to the Winnetu
  - Carpooling or use of island cabs or rideshares is strongly encouraged.
